Mission Australia has released its National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Youth Report 2017. Over 24,000 young people responded to Mission Australia’s 2017 Youth Survey and over 1,200, or 5.3 per cent, of respondents were Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander young people. The respondents come from all states and territories and live in major cities as well as regional areas, and the report provides important insights into the aspirations, experiences, and concerns of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander young people.
